Time Keeping - Special Test Schedule: _____

Dear Rider:

This year the 200 will start at Jensen Welding & Machine works Inc, at 840 Leilani St. Hilo, Hawaii. The same place as last year. We will go right through down town Hilo. So we need say no more about legal & noise. Last year we made our point: noise will kill this event sooner than anything. That is assuming some berserko doesn't crash into somebody not involved in the 200, first. We had a close call last year with accidents - no more, please!

People shipping there bikes over can have us pick them up and keep them at the shop, or anything, anyway we can help. Just let us know what you need.

We have some of the most beautiful Koa wood bowls for trophies for the top five over all and the Dealer and Club team sponsors. These and finisher pins all took a big chunk of bread, so we hope you appreciate them. The top three in each class will get regular trophies.

The trail seems harder to me this year even though it is still a lot of the same areas. Could be this is just a hard year all around. The first day will have four secret checks for time keeping and a special test time keeping section that is in the course starting at check point six (which is known). Ride this one as close as you can to the middle of your minute, cause it is the tie breaker. Of course there is the cross country special test where we time you on a measured course (which is all part of the schedule). You wont have to worry about getting to the next check too soon, just blast it. Then the second day we have no secret checks, just get in under time. Believe me, the times are all realistic, and the top riders who don't make a mistake or have mechanical problems will zero the second day. So what it amounts to, is: play it cool on the second day, ride the schedule, don't break your bike or body, don't make any mistakes.

Look around. Take a few seconds from time to time to look around. This is the most beautiful ride yet. Kauai has some of the most beautiful vistas I have ever seen. This island is completely different, and just as beautiful.

We increased our quota to seventyfive riders since we have taken the house keeping cabins. But that is the absolute limite, even if sleeping accomodations weren't a factor.
